The Osborne Practice

We are 1 of 26 practices in Portsmouth and have **11,150 registered patients.**

Our team consists of 6 Doctors, 4 Practice Nurses, 2 Healthcare Assistants and 20 Administrative Staff.

In 2010 our Doctors conducted 3,463 telephone consultations, 1,619 home visits and **49,726 face to face consultations.**

Our Nurses conducted 613 telephone consultations, 3,423 healthcare assistant appointments and **21,943 face to face consultations.**

We help many people who live with chronic illnesses such as Asthma, COPD, Diabetes, Dementia, Epilepsy, Heart Disease, Hypertension, and Schizophrenia with **3,898 patients on regular medication and repeat prescriptions.**

We work to prevent illnesses and screen for early diagnoses Antenatal care, cardiovascular risk reduction assessment, cervical smears, childhood immunisations, contraception, Influenza immunisations, mammography, travel immunisations and regular health checks for those with chronic illnesses.

Some numbers from 2010...

16% are obese, 22% smoke, 10% have alcohol related problems and we stabilised 17 drug users with replacement medication.

36 patients were diagnosed with cancer (15 breast and 9 prostate).

350 patients with depression and anxiety were treated with medication and talking therapies.

There were 15 gallbladder, 72 cataract and 4 appendix surgeries.

145 babies were born, 123 patients died (35% in their own homes), 16 patients had heart attacks and 14 patients had strokes (and survived).

Also, over the last decade, 13 patients have been treated for TB and over 20 we know of are living with HIV.
